The general nature and effect of the Orders will be to:

- (a) add new pay & display parking place outside nos.116/118 Fortune Green Road.
- (b) Shorten existing shared-use (resident/pay & display) outside Weech Hall;
- (c) Extend existing shared-use bay opposite nos.100 to 108 Fortune Green Road.
- (d) Add new motorcycle parking place opposite no.108 Fortune Green Road.
- (e) Amend existing yellow line opposite new vehicle entrances opposite 116/118 Fortune Green Road to operate between 7.15am – 8.00pm on Mondays to Fridays; between 9.00am-8.00pm on Saturdays and between 10am-8.00pm on Sundays.
- (f) To relocate the existing disabled persons parking place in ouside no.150 Loudoun Road, north-westward for 3.0 metres.
- (g) To relocate the two existing resident parking places outside 150 Loudoun Road to accommodate the new location of the vehicle property entrance.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey, hereinafter called the Council, on 1st October

2009 made the above mentioned Order under sections 6, 45, 46 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act

- 2. The general effect of the waiting and loading Order would be to introduce double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions on:
- (a) Alexandra Road, N8

both sides, between its junction with Turnpike Lane and a point 10.0 metres north-west of that junction.

- (b) Hornsey Park Road, N8, the north-east side, between the southern kerb-line of Turnpike Lane and a point 12.0 metres south of that iunction:
- (c) Turnpike Lane, N8
- (i) the north-west side.
- (1). between its junction with Hornsey Park Road, N8 and a point 50.0 metres east of that junction;
- (2). between a point 12.0 metres west of its junction with Alexandra Road, N8 and a point 20.0 metres east of that junction;
- (ii) the south-east side, between and outside,
- (1). Nos. 5 to 9 Turnpike Lane;
- (2). Nos. 63 to 65 Turnpike Lane; (3). Nos. 79 to 97 Turnpike Lane, N8; and
- (4). Nos. 127 and its junction with Hornsey Park Road, N8.
- 3. The general effect of the 20MPH Order would be to introduce a 20m.p.h. speed limit on Hornsey Park Road, N8, located between a point opposite the north-western most wall of Nos. 161 to 197 and a point opposite the southern most wall of No. 10 Hornsey Park Road,
- 4. The general effect of the free loading Order would be to on Turnpike Lane formalise existing on street loading bays located outside Nos.:
- (a) the north-west side,

66 to 70 Turnpike Lane, operative Monday to Saturday 9.00am and 11.30am AND 2.00pm and 4.00pm; and

(b) the south-east side.

99 to 107 Turnpike Lane, N8, operative Monday to Saturday 9.00am and 6.00pm.

The loading bays will operate with a maximum loading period of 1 hour and where a return will be prohibited for 1 hour.

- 5. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 4th October 2009, these Orders being amended, of the Council's statement of reasons for making the Orders, together with plans and more detailed particulars showing the locations and effects of these Orders may be inspected during normal office working hours, until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, or as the case may be, the Council decides not to make these Orders, Sustainable Transport, TEAM GROUP, 1st Floor (South), River Park House, 225 High Road, Wood Green, London N22 8HQ.
