7. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

- (xi) Outside Tarrantt House for a distance of four metres;
- (xii) Outside Todber House for a distance of five metres;
- (v) St. Charles Square, to provide one Blue Badge Disabled parking space opposite Nos. 11 to 14 Balfour House, St. Charles Square, by converting a pay and display parking space;
- (w) Stackhouse Street, to convert the single yellow lines on both sides of Stackhouse Street to 'at any time' waiting restrictions for a total distance of 109 metres;
