## From Manuer, July 24. to ELUIDER July 27. 1671.

## Whitehall, July 26.

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Is Majefty leaving Dartmouth the 23 in flant in the Evening, attended by his Grace the Duke of Monmouth, and teveral other perfons of quality (his Royal Highnefs remaining there on board his Yachts, with intentions to return by Sea) arrived that night

at Exeter, where His Majefly was received by the Mayor, (upon whom His Majefly was pleafed to confer the Honor of Knighthood, as he had done the day before at Dartmouth upon Mr. Thomas Carem their Recorder) and Aldermen, with the due Ceremonies, at the Gate of the City: The next morning early, His Majefly parting again from thence towards salisbury, was pleafed to lodge that night at the Earl of Pembroke's Houfe at Wilzon, within two miles of that place, which His Majefly paffed the next morning, and in the Evening arrived here in perfect health. About the fame time Her Majefly likewife arrived here, with Her Court from Hampton-Court.

Her Court from Hampton-Court. Moskow, June 6. The 2 inftant the great Re-bell Stephan Radzin was brought Prisoner hither, in the manner following; first marched a Guard of Foot, confilting of about 400 Men, with flying Colours, and lighted Match; next, a party of Collacks, under the Command of Cornels Tacolowich, who it feems took him Prisoner, then the Rebel placed upon a Scaffold made for that purpole, to be drawn by Horles, upon which was crected a Gallowes, under which he flood, with a chain about his Neckfastned to the Gallowes, with a halter hanging by it, about his middle and hands were other chains, and upon his feet shackles; then followed his Brother on Foot, with a chain about his neck, which was failed to the Scaffold, and last of all came several Companies of Foot of the Czars Guards; the Rebel was immediately after his ar rival put to the Torture , where it is faid, he made a large Confession, of which we yet want the particulars : The fame day he was condemned to fuffer death, which yesterday, after having been again sortured, he accordingly did in the open place be fore the Caffie, a long Scroul, containing all the Crimes and Milchie's committed by him, fince the Year 1663. having been first read upon the place; his Arms, Leggs, and 11-1d, were fit up in the principal place of th. Town, upon five poles, the Trunck of his Body having been left in the Streets, to be devoured by Dogs and other Creatures . his Brother was prefent all the time of his Execution, and afterwards returned to prilon again, what his Sentence may be, we as yet we know not. It is faid, that the City of Aftracan hath rendred it felt, and fworn Allegiance to the Czar, which if true will doubtles put a ftop to the troubles which have to long interrupted the quiec of these Countries.

Rome, July 11. The Treaty of agreement which was lately thought to have been very nigh concluding, between the Connectable of Colonna, and the Pringes de Sulmona and de Palestrina-Borghese, conbrang the Rade to Warz to have at any publick blemnity, at which they should all three be obliged to be present, is it seems now wholly broken off again, to the great diffutisfaction of the Cardinais Facel inetti, Delfino, and others who appeared extraordinary active, for the promoting this good understanding between them

This week his Holinefs finding himfelf in reafonable good health, was pleafed to give Audience to the Ambaffadors and other Forreign Minifters at prefent refiding here.

The Marriage formerly spoken of between the Niece of the Cardinal Facchinetti, and the Prince Pumphilio, is, as is faid, to be very faddainly confummated, with the good liking and fatisfaction of their Friends and Relations on both fides. On Tuefday last the Bishop of Laon had Audience of his Holiness, by whom he was received with muchkindness and efteem; after which he made leveral vifits, though in a very private manner, his Trayn not being yet in a condition, which is intended to be extreme pompous and magnificent, to appear with him in publick.

Here is at prefent ill in Town, the Cardinals, Spada, Acquiviva, Vidoni, Bonelli, and Colfo, though without any great fear of danger, except the firft, who is faid to be in a very weak condition. Our laft Letters from M4drid tell us, that the Queen Regent hath reiterated her express Orders to Don Pcdro d'Arragon Vice-Roy of Naples, for the giving all poffible fatisfaction to the Marquis de Villa Franca, in feveral matters he hath complained to have been injured in, at the return of that Vice-Roy from his late Embaffy of Qbedierce; after which, that Marquefs, intends tormake all poffible haft for Madrid to fetch his Lady, being, as isfaid, to fucceed the Marquefs d'Aftorgus here, as Ambaffador Extraordinary from the Crown of Spain.

Some days fince arrived here the Marquels Cornetio Frangipani to follicite the recovery of the Effate of the Marquels of that name, who lately fuffered at Niewjlad concerning the Rebellion in Hungary, to whom he is next Heir; which the Chamber of Actounts here, had fince feifed upon, as pretending it to have been forfeited to the Church; it is thought, by the affiftance of powerful Friends, and amonght others of the Cardinal Antonio, he may in a fnort time come to rights in this affair.

The 7th inflant arrived here the English Ferufalem from Gallipoli with Oyle, and the Owners Delight from the Gulf of Venice with Hemp, and the 11 departed again for England. We have advice, that the Galleys of Maltha have lately taken an Argiers man of War of confiderable Force, though with the loss of near 150 Men, b. fides other dammage they received in the rencounter.

Venice, July 17. The 15 inflant went hence Proveditor General Morofini towards Dalmatia, where he is to fucceed General Barbaro; the Gally which transports his Excellency to Zara, is to pais thence to Zant, to joyn with the reft of the Fleet under the command of General Bernardo there. About the beginning of the next week Cavaglier Quirini, parts hence on his Embasily to the Port, most of his Equippage and Attendant being all eady gone.
