### (VARIOUS LOCATIONS)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley on 22nd April 2010 made the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 47, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985 and of all other powers thereunto enabling, which will come into operation on 10th May 2010.

The effect of the Orders would be to:-

(a) introduce/extend/amend the waiting and loading restrictions as specified in the Schedule to this notice;

(b) remove one time restricted free parking space in Anerley Road, Penge (near its junction with Anerley Park) and replace with At Any Time waiting restrictions as specified in the Schedule to this notice

(c) introduce additional Pay and Display parking spaces in Park Road, Beckenham as specified in the Schedule to this notice;

(d) redefine the location of the Pay and Display parking spaces in Lych Gate Road, Orpington following the relocation of the entrance to Orpington College car park as specified in the Schedule to this notice.

A copy of the Orders may be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at the Bromley Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, Kent until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from the date of making the Orders.

ANY person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that any requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
