1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 1st June 2010 the 'Council' of the London Borough of Haringey made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be to:-

(a) create a controlled parking zone 'Woodside CPZ' in the Eldon Road, N22 area in which the waiting by vehicles, other than in the parking places provided, between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive will be prohibited in the streets or lengths of streets referred to in Schedule 1 to this Notice;

(b) extend the 'Wood Green Outer CPZ' to include the northern section of Perth Road, N22 and Fife Road N22, in which the waiting by vehicles, other than in the parking places provided, between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive will be prohibited;

(c) designate residents parking places, on certain lengths of the streets specified in;

(i) Schedule 1 to this Notice, operative between 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;

(ii) Schedule 2 to this Notice, operative between 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;

where vehicles displaying a valid residents parking permit or a visitors' permit would be permitted to wait without time limit;

(d) designate shared use residents, business and pay and display parking places, on certain lengths of street specified in;

(i) Schedule 6 to this Notice, operative between 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;

(ii) Schedule 7 to this Notice operative between 8.00 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;

where vehicles displaying:-

a valid residents parking permit, a business permit or a visitors' permit would be permitted to wait without time limit; or a pay and display ticket would be permitted to wait for a maximum period of two hours with no return to that parking place within 2 hours of leaving it [the charges for the Pay and display method would be as is current for the existing Wood Green CPZ];

(e) adjust all disabled bays in the roads listed in Schedule 1 so as to meet the accessibility needs of all disabled drivers;

(f) introduce new double yellow lines, on certain lengths of the streets specified in Schedule 5 to this Notice (mainly at junctions and points of access unless otherwise stated) so that the waiting by vehicles other than for the purpose of loading/unloading or for the delivery or collection of goods would be prohibited "at any time".

3. Resident or business users whose property is indicated in Schedules 3 and 4 to this Notice may purchase parking permits and residents may purchase visitors parking permits, for passenger vehicles, goods carrying vehicles (the overall height of which does not exceed 2.27 metres and the overall length of which does not exceed 5.25 metres) or invalid carriages, at the rates set out below:-
