UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT 1923

A Statute made by the University of Cambridge, on 1st July 2010 amending Statutes A and D has been submitted for the approval of Her Majesty in Council, and notice of this having been submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923. Under the provisions of the Act any petition must be received by the Privy Council Office, 2 Carlton Gardens, London SW1Y 5AA within eight weeks (exclusive of any University vacation).

1. The purposes of the proposed amendments are to:

- (i) to extend eligibility for membership of the Senate (senior members of the University);
- (ii) to correct an error referring to the election of student members of the University Council; and
- (iii) to include newly established Visiting Professorships in the list of such Professorships which may be held by persons over the age of 67 years. (1162959)
