1. The London Borough of Hounslow gives notice that it intends to make the above Order under sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

POWER ROAD

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HOUNSLOW (PARKING PLACES) (NO. 2) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2010

1. The London Borough of Hounslow hereby gives Notice that on the 12 July 2010 it made the above Order under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.
2. The general effect of the Order, which comes into effect on 26 July 2010, will be to reduce the length of the pay & display parking space, opposite No.114 Power Road, from 47m to 18m to cater for a new 29m long bus stop clearway. The Order revokes The London Borough of Hounslow (Parking Places) (No.1) Experimental Order 2010.
3. The Order provides that the Director of Environment, or a person authorised by him, may, if it appears to him or that person essential

in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs, modify or suspend the Order or any provision thereof.

4. Documents giving more detailed information are available for inspection, online at www.hounslow.gov.uk or at the Forms and Documents Counter in the reception of the Civic Centre, Lampton Road, Hounslow TW3 4DN between the hours of 9am and 4.15pm Mondays to Fridays, until the end of eighteen months from the date on which this Notice is published. 5. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the 1984 Act, or that any requirement of the Act, or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

6. If the provisions of the Order continue in operation for a period of at least six months, the Council will consider in due course whether the provisions of the experimental Order should be continued in force indefinitely by means of a permanent Order. Any person desiring to object to the making of an Order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation may, within six months of the Order coming into operation, send a statement in writing of the objection and the grounds on which it is made to the Director of Environment at the above address quoting the reference TMO/E002/10.
