E have received an Account from Riga, that the Duke of Holftein having been invited thither by Prince Repnin to an Entertainment he made for the Czar and the principal Perfons of his Court in the Easter Holidays, does fince appear publickly at that Court, and the Czar has given him Apartments near his own. Itwas talked that his Czarish Majesty would soon go to Revel, and take the Duke of Holstein with M. Tolftoy and M. Ofterman were with him. the Czar at Riga, the latter being ordered to be ready to repair to Neuftad, as foon as an Answer should come from the Swedish Court to the Propositions carried thither from the Czar by M. Campredon, M. Tolftoy the younger paffed through this Place on the 17th Instant on his Way to Copenhagen, with a Meffage from the Czar to the King of Den-It is advised from Warfaw, that the mark. King of Poland defigned to fet out from thence on the 10th of next Month, on his Return to Saxony: The Command of the Troops refigned by Count Fleming, had been divided between Prince Lubomirski and Count Denhof, the first being made General of the Horse and the other of the Foot.

Madrid, April 23, N. S. Cardinal Borgia fet out from hence on the 12th Inftant for Alicant, where he will be met by Cardinal Belluga: Commadore Don Antonio Serrano, who by the King's Command went thither from Cadiz with three Men of War, two of which are Ships of the Line, attends their coming, in order to carry them to Civita-vecchia, whence they are to proceed to Rome, to be prefent at the Election of a new Pope. 50000 Pieces of Eight have been iffued to each of these Cardinals out of the Royal Treasury, towards their Expences on this Occafion; and they are accompanied by the Abbots Portocarrero and Baeza, both Sons of Grandess of Spain. On the 15th in the Morning the Marquels de Lede took Polfeffion of the Dignity of Grandee of Spain, by putting on his Hat in the King's Prefence; on which Occasion there was a numerous Appearance at Court of Grandees, Nobles, and Military Officers. On the 16th their Catholick Majefties, with the Prince of Afturias and the Infantes, set out for Aranjuez; attended by the Marquels de Grimaldo Secretary of State. The King being informed that the Merchants are flow in lading the Galleons for

New Spain, Orders have been dispatched to Cadiz, for three of the five Ships fitted out at his Majefty's Charge, to get ready to fail by the 8th of May at furthes, without waiting for any more Cargoes than what they shall have then on Board, and for the other two to follow them before the End of the same Month. On the 18th in the Evening arrived here the Earl of Portmore, from his Government of Gibraltar, on his Way to Great Britain. Yesterday Collonel Stanhope carried his Lordship to the Court at Aranjuez, where he had Audience of the King and Queen, by whom he was received with great Marks of Favour 9 he had Audience also of the Prince of Asturias, and asterwards dined with the Marquess de Grimaldo.

Turin, April 30, N. S. The two Battallions of the King of Sardinia's Guards are marched from hence to Sufa, where they lye ready to be divided into Detachments, as foon as the Snow on the Mountains is melted, in order to guard the Paffages from France, for preventing the bringing of the contagious Diftemper into this Country. The King has declared the Marquefs de Villaclara Governour in chief of the Kingdom of Sardinia: He is one of the principal Men of that Ifland, and came hither lately as their Deputy to pay their Duty to their new King: He continues ftill here.

Paris, May 7. On the 3d Inftant the King accompanied by the Duke Regent, the Duke of Chartres, the reft of the Princes of the Blood, and a numerous Court, went to the Plain des Sablons to review the Regiments of the French and Swifs Guards. The Turkifh The Turkish Ambassadour went likewise thither to see that Review, being attended by 20 of his own Servants on Horleback; and on the 5th that Am-baffadour made a Visit to the Count de Touloule as Admiral of France, to whom he delivered a Letter from the Captain Balhaw, and was received by that Prince with great Marks of Distinction. The Duke de la Force being returned from his Country Seat in Normandy, went on the 3d Inftant to the Palais, where he was again examined by Meff. Ferrant and Paris, Councellours of the Great Chamber, and on the 5th the Parliament was affembled upon that Affair, the Decision whereof was put off to arother Day. In the mean while the Duke has cauled a Memorial to be pub-lifhed for his Justification : M. Bernard his Secretary, continues in Prilon, notwithflanding a Petition he had cauled to be prelented
