THE EALING (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION)
(SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (AMENDMENT NO. 445)
ORDER 2011

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing Council on the 6th January 2011 made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.
2. The general effect of the Order will be to extend the double yellow lines prohibiting waiting by vehicles at any time in Old Oak Common Lane, W3 on its north-east side, between the northern extremity of the first railway bridge lying immediately north of Nos. 203/205 Old Oak Common Lane and the south-eastern kerb-line of the unnamed access road opposite Nos. 23 and 25 Wells House Road and to introduce a further length of double yellow lines on its south-west side, between the rear common boundary of Nos. 45 and 47 Wells House
