CONTROLLED PARKING ZONES: VALIDITY OF PERMITS IN ALL ZONES AND VARIOUS OTHER AMENDMENTS

THE ISLINGTON (PARKING PLACES) (VARIOUS ZONES) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 201*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Islington proposes to make the above mentioned Order under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985, and all other enabling powers.

2. The general effect of the Parking Places Order will be to amend the Controlled Parking Zone Traffic Management Orders so that:

In any Controlled Parking Zone in the London Borough of Islington, between the hours of 11.00 am and 3.00 pm on any day of the week (should those hours fall within the controlled hours of any Zone), any valid Residents' Parking Permit displayed in the correct manner on a vehicle for which that permit was issued shall be accepted as a valid Residents' Parking Permit for that Zone;

IMPORTANT: The above shall not apply during the extended hours of control on a match/event day within any match/event day parking zone, should those extended hours fall between 11.00 am and 3.00 pm. Therefore, on weekends or public holidays when there is a match/event day, roaming permit validity shall cease at the following times:

Zone E

1.30 pm where the match/event day falls on a Saturday

Noon where the match/event day falls on a Sunday or a public holiday Zone F

1.30 pm where the match/event day falls on a Saturday

Noon where the match/event day falls on a Sunday or a public holiday Zone G

Noon where the match/event day falls on a Saturday, Sunday or a public holiday

Zone H

3.00 pm where the match/event day falls on a Saturday

Noon where the match/event day falls on a Sunday or a public holiday Zone J

3.00 pm where the match/event day falls on a Saturday

Noon where the match/event day falls on a Sunday or a public holiday Zone L

1.30 pm where the match/event day falls on a Saturday

Noon where the match/event day falls on a Sunday or a public holiday Zone N

1.30 pm where the match/event day falls on a Saturday

Noon where the match/event day falls on a Sunday or a public holiday Zone Q

Noon where the match/event day falls on a Saturday, Sunday or a public holiday

Zone V

1.30 pm where the match/event day falls on a Saturday

Noon where the match/event day falls on a Sunday or a public holiday Zone Y

1.30 pm where the match/event day falls on a Saturday

Noon where the match/event day falls on a Sunday or a public holiday

CHANGE OF PARKING BAY FUNCTION IN INWOOD ROAD AND CHANGE IN LOADING BAY RESTRICTIONS IN KINGSLEY ROAD, HOUNSLOW.

A. THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HOUNSLOW (HOUNSLOW TOWN CENTRE) (PARKING PLACES) (2009, NO. 18) (AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 20**

B. THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HOUNSLOW (LOADING PLACES) (2009, NO. 1) (AMENDMENT NO. **) ORDER 20**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Hounslow proposes to make the above mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

2. The general effect of the Parking Places Order would be to further amend The Hounslow (Hounslow Town Centre) (Parking Places) (No. 18) Order 2009 which imposes the Hounslow Town Centre Parking Scheme so that business permit holder bays in Inwood Road would be converted to dual use bays thereby allowing both residents' and business permit holders to park as detailed in Schedule 1 to this Notice.

3. The general effect of the Loading Places Order would be to further amend the London Borough of Hounslow (Loading Places) (No. 1) Order 2008 by changing the loading bay outside No. 6 Kingsley Road from a "goods only vehicle" loading bay to a general use loading bay as detailed in the Schedule to this Notice. The loading bay will still operate during the same times.

4. (proposed conversion of business permit holder bay to allow both business and residents' permit holders – Mon to Fri 9.30am to 6pm and Sat 9.30am to 12.30pm)

Inwood Road, Hounslow - north-west, from a point 10 metres south of a point opposite the northern boundary of No. 119 Inwood Road, southwards, for a distance of 29.0 metres

Inwood Road, Hounslow - south, from a point 1 metre south of a point opposite the south-western wall of No. 108 Inwood Road, southwards, for a distance of 57.0 metres
