Copenhagen, June 30, N. S.

N the 18th Instant the King of Denmark with the whole Court went to Fredericksberg, and the next Day his Majefty with the Prince Royal came within a Majerty while the trince how, and took a Review of the Regiments of Foot-Guards, as also of Prince Christian's, Prince Charles's, Zepetin's, and one Battallion of the Prince of Sunderburg's. His Majefty went after the Review to Walloe, a Country Seat belonging to the Queen, and returned to Fredericksberg the 28th, where he created that Day the following Gen tlemen Knights of the Order of Dannebrog.viz. M. Virek, M. Geridorf, and M. Holft. This. Day his Majefty reviewed his Horfe-Guards, and a Regiment of Dragoons called the Jut-land Regiment. The Prince Royal fers out in a few Days to Travel, attended by Count Holft, who was lately made Great Chancellour of this Kingdom. The King's Journey to Holftein, is put off for fome time. Dantzick, June 14, O. S. Yefterday arrived

here from Riga the Danish Envoy M. Westphale, who upon the Czar's Departure from thence for Revel had his Audience of Leave, and is now returning to Copenhagen. He re-ports, that the Czar during his Stay at Riga had a very dangerous Fit of Sickneis, and is fill in a weak State of Health ; and that his Czarish Majesty's largest Men of War keep within the Harbour of Cronflot. A few Days ago the King of Pruffia reviewed near Coningsberg 11 Regiments, which are fince gone back to their respective Quarters; and his Majesty is gone on in his Progress through those Parts of his Dominions. Yesterday palfed through this Place Prince George of Heffe Caffel, who came from Sweden, and is going

to the King of Pruffia. Madrid, June 23. The King, Queen, and Royal Family, having come hither lome Days ago from Aranjuez, to affift at the ufual Proceffions and Devotions on the Festival called Corpus Christi, went on the 16th Instant to the Escurial for the rest of the Summer Season. We have an Account from Rome, that the two Spanish Cardinals arrived at Civita Vecchia on the 25th of May, and proceeded from thence to Rome, where they wait for Orders from this Court. An Express from Oadiz has brought the News, that an Advice-Ship from Pern is arrived there : By this Ship are alfo come Letters from Mexico dated in March laft,

which the took in at the Havana. The King in Confideration of the great Services of the Marquess de Grimaldo, Secretary of the Difpatches, has promoted him to the Dignity of Counsellour of State.

Paris, July 5. On the 30th paft a Lettre de Cachet was sent to M. Jollain, Syndick of the Sorbonne, to remove him not only from that Employment; but allo from his Degree of Doctor of that Faculty, and to order him not to appear any more at their Affembly. The next Day the Sorbonne had its ufual monthly Meeting, wherein an Order from the King was produced, appointing M. de Romigny, Nephew to M. Chartron, Dean of that Faculty, Syndick in the Room of the faid M. Jollain: Whereupon great Debates atifing, 108 Doctors voted to fend Deputies to the King, to make proper Reprefentations, and to intreat his Majeffy to maintain them in their Privileges, and 52 were for an abfolute Compliance with the King's Orders : Which Orders concerning the Syndick being very politive, he was suffered to enter upon his Employment. On the 2d Inflant the Parliament affembled upon the Duke de la Force's Affair, moft of the Princes of the Blood, Dukes and Peers, being present, but no Resolution was taken in it by Reason of two Memorials which were prefented that Morning to the Parliament by the Company of the Sellers of Earthen Ware, and the Diffillers of this City, concerning 22 Chefts of China Ware, and feveral Pipes of Alicant Wine which had been feized fome time ago, and which they petition may be confilcated to their Profit. Thele two Memorials were ordered to be communi ated to the adverse Party, and another Meeting is appointed on the 7th Infant. Nothing was refolved upon in the laft Council of Regency with Relation to the In-dia Company. Two bundred and ten Clerks are appointed at the Bank, for putting into Order all the Paper-Effects which have been examined in the feveral Offices established for that Purpole.
