THE HAMMERSMITH AND FULHAM (PARKING PLACES, ZONE L) (AMENDMENT NO. 1) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2011

- 3. The general effect of the Hammersmith and Fulham (Parking Places, Zone L) (Amendment No. 1) Experimental Order 2011 will be to, as an experiment, revoke a section of parking place on the east side of Nasmyth Street near the junction with Dalling Road.
- 4. The Council will consider in due course whether the provisions of the Order should be reproduced and continued in force indefinitely by means of an Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1984. Any person wishing to object to the making of an Order for the purpose of such reproduction and continuation may, within the abovementioned period of six months, or if any of the Orders are varied by another Order or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the 1984 Act, beginning with the day on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force, send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds on which it is made to the Assistant Director - Highways and Engineering at the address above. 7. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements of that Act or of any relevant regulations made under that Act have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
