1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be to:

(a) create a controlled parking zone ‘*Stroud Green CPZ*’ in which the waiting by vehicles, other than in the parking places provided, between the hours of Noon and 2:00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive will be prohibited in the streets or lengths of streets referred to in Schedule 1 to this Notice. Parking places on those streets will operate at the aforementioned hours and in which vehicles displaying a valid residents parking permit or a visitors’ permit would be permitted to wait without time limit;

(b) create controlled parking zones ‘*Finsbury Park CPZ*’, ‘*Finsbury Park B*’ CPZ and ‘*Finsbury Park C*’ in which the waiting by vehicles, other than in the parking places provided, between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive and between the hours of Noon and 4.30 p.m. on Sundays, Bank Holidays and Match/Event days will be prohibited in the streets or lengths of streets referred to in Schedule 2 to this Notice. Parking places on those streets will operate at the aforementioned hours and in which vehicles displaying a valid residents parking permit or a visitors’ permit would be permitted to wait without time limit;

(c) designate pay and display parking places, on certain lengths of street specified in;

(i) Schedule 3 to this Notice, operative between the hours of Noon and 2:00 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;

(ii) Schedule 4 to this Notice operative between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive and between the hours of Noon and 4.30 p.m. on Sundays, Bank Holidays and Match/Event days;

where vehicles displaying a pay and display ticket would be permitted to wait for a maximum period of two hours with no return to that parking place within 2 hours of leaving it [the charges for the Pay and display method would be as set out below] [in many cases the parking places will be shared with residents, business or visitors’ permit parking];

(d) adjust all disabled bays in the roads listed in the Schedules so as to meet the accessibility needs of all disabled drivers;

(e) introduce new double yellow lines, on lengths of the streets specified in the Schedules to this Notice (mainly at junctions and points of access) so that the waiting by vehicles other than for the purpose of loading/unloading or for the delivery or collection of goods would be prohibited “at any time”.

3. Residents whose postal address lies within Colton Gardens may purchase parking permits and visitors parking permits, for passenger vehicles, goods carrying vehicles (the overall height of which does not exceed 2.27 metres and the overall length of which does not exceed 5.25 metres) or invalid carriages, at the rates set out below:

ALL VEHICLES:

Business Permit (1st vehicle) - £240; Essential service permit three hours permit short stay - £40 per set of 10 permits (entitlement of 300 per annum); Residents short stay one hour visitors’ permit – 30p; Residents short stay two hours visitors’ permit - 60p; Residents daily visitors’ permit – £3.00; Residents weekend visitors’ permit (valid noon Friday for 72 hours) - £7.50; Residents long stay visitors’ permit (14 days) - £12.00.

Residents over 60 and registered disabled receive 50% concession on all visitor permits.

The permits for the controlled parking zone would only be valid in the zone for which they are issued. The maximum annual entitlement of visitors’ permits would be 720 short stay permits, 12 weekend visitor permits and 2 long stay permits. The maximum annual entitlement for residents aged 60 would be 1440 short stay permits, 24 weekend visitor permits and 4 long stay permits.

4. Copies of the proposed Orders, the Orders being amended and of the Council’s statement of reasons for making the Orders and plans showing the locations and effects of the Orders may be inspected during a period of 21 days from the date on which this Notice is published,
