

London Borough of Bexley**THE BEXLEY (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO.26) TRAFFIC ORDER 2012**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bexley on 16th April 2012, made the above mentioned Order under sections 6, and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985.
2. The general effect of the Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No.26) Traffic Order 2012 would be to further amend the Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2009 to:—
- (a) Extend existing waiting restrictions (8:00am – 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday) in parts of Burnt Oak Lane, Bexleyheath;
- (b) introduce waiting restrictions ('At any time') in parts of Burnt Oak Lane, Bexleyheath; and
- (c) convert existing waiting restrictions (8:00am – 6:30pm, Monday to Saturday) to operate 'At any time' in parts of The Oval (service road)
3. Copies of the Order, which will come into effect on 23rd April 2012, the Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Traffic Order 2009 (and the Orders that have amended that Order), the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order and maps which indicate the length of roads to which the Orders relate can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, at the Contact Centre, Civic Offices, Bexleyheath, Kent DA6 7LB.

Croydon Council**PROPOSED EXTENSION OF THE CROYDON EAST OUTER CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE IN ALEXANDRA ROAD AND HASTINGS ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council propose to make a Traffic Order under Sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.
2. **The general effect of the Order will be to introduce 6 'Shared-use Permit/Pay and Display' parking bays in the Croydon East Outer Controlled Parking Zone in Alexandra Road, outside No. 9 Alexandra Road (1 bay) and in Hastings Road, outside Nos. 2 to 14 Hastings Road (5 bays).**
