#### SCHEDULE 1 - WAITING RESTRICTIONS OPERATING “AT ANY TIME”

##### Beaconsfield Road

between the western kerb-line of Hermit Road and a point 12 metres west of that kerb-line.

##### Bethell Avenue

between the eastern kerb-line of Hermit Road and a point 10 metres east of that kerb-line.

##### Blake Road

between the western kerb-line of Hermit Road and a point 10 metres west of that kerb-line.

##### Blanche Street

between the eastern kerb-line of Hermit Road and a point 10 metres east of that kerb-line.

##### Boleyn Road E7

(a) the north side, between the eastern kerb-line of Upton Lane and a point 10 metres east of that kerb-line;

(b) the south side, between the eastern kerb-line of Upton Lane and a point 10 metres east of that kerb-line.

##### Chesterton Terrace

(a) the north side, between the eastern kerb-line of Upper Road and a point 15.5 metres east of that kerb-line;

(b) the south side, between the eastern kerb-line of Upper Road and a point 17.7 metres east of that kerb-line.

##### Clifford Road

between the western kerb-line of Hermit Road and a point 7.2 metres west of that kerb-line.

##### Elim Way

between the southern kerb-line of Grange Road and a point 10 metres south of that kerb-line.

##### Florence Road E13

(a) the north-west side, between the western kerb-line of Upper Road and a point 10 metres south-west of that kerb-line;

(b) the south-east side, between the western kerb-line of Upper Road and a point 10 metres south-west of that kerb-line.

##### Grange Road

(a) the north side

(i) between a point 10 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Upper Road and a point 3 metres west of the common boundary of Nos. 168 and 170 Grange Road;

(ii) between a point 1.5 metres west of the western boundary of No. 230 Grange Road and the common boundary of Nos. 230b and 232 Upper Road;

(iii) between the common boundary of Nos. 236 and 238 Grange Road and the common boundary of 254 and 252 Grange Road;

(b) the south side

(i) from a point 2 metres west of a point opposite the western wall of No. 11 Morse Close eastward for a distance of 20 metres;

(ii) between a point 10 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Upper Road and a point 3 metres west of the common boundary of Nos. 168 and 170 Grange Road;

(iii) between a point 10 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Suffolk Road and a point 10 metres west of the western kerb-line of Suffolk Road;

(iv) between a point 12.6 metres east of the eastern kerb-line of Elim Way and a point 10 metres west of the western kerb-line of Elim Way;

(v) between the north-western kerb-line of Hermit Road and the common boundary of Nos. 252 and 254 Grange Road.

##### Hermit Road

(a) the east and north-east side

(i) between a point 10 metres south of the southern kerb-line of Blanche Street and a point 10 metres north of the northern kerb-line of Blanche Street;
