##### DESIGNATION OF A MONMOUTHSHIRE AND BRECON CANAL CONSERVATION AREA

Notice is hereby given under the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990 Section 69 that Torfaen County Borough Council, as the Local Planning Authority, has determined that the following area is of special architectural or historic interest, the character or appearance of which it is desirable to preserve or enhance and has therefore on the 28th of June 2011 designated the following area as a conservation area:

##### SCHEDULE

The entire length of the Monmouthshire and Brecon Canal from Usk Road, immediately south of the boundary with the Brecon Beacons National Park to the boundary with Newport City Council, together

with certain adjoining land, to be known as the “Monmouthshire and Brecon Canal Conservation Area”.

##### DESIGNATION OF EXTENSIONS TO THE BOUNDARY OF BLAENAVON CONSERVATION AREA

The effect of these designations as conservation areas is as follows:

Conservation area consent will now be required for the demolition of all buildings over 115m<sup>3</sup> in the conservation area.

It is an offence, subject to certain exceptions, to cut down, top, lop, uproot, wilfully damage or destroy any tree in the conservation area except with consent of the Local Planning Authority.

Planning Applications which would in the opinion of the Local Planning Authority affect the character or appearance of the conservation area must be publicised and representations received as a result must be taken into account in determining the application.

The Local Planning Authority has a duty to formulate and publish proposals for the preservation and enhancement of the conservation area.

A character statement, including a map showing the extent of the Monmouth and Brecon Canal Conservation Area, and the extensions to Blaenavon Conservation Area is available on Torfaen County Borough Council's website ([www.torfaen.gov.uk](http://www.torfaen.gov.uk)) and may be inspected at either the Civic Offices, Glantorfaen Road, Pontypool, or the County Hall, Cwmbran (Monday to Friday, 9.00am to 5.00pm)

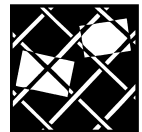
