inclusive, with a new maximum stay of two hours which applies to the parking places within the two zones. The two hour max stay does not apply to any vehicle which displays an activated SMART Visitor Permit for that specific zone

(8) introduce 'no loading at any time' restrictions which operate in lengths of Seagrave Road.

(9) ban stopping by vehicles in certain lengths of Lillie Road which fall between North End Road and the boundary with the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea, at any time in certain lengths and between 6 am and Midnight on Mondays to Sundays in other lengths (exemptions will apply for official games vehicles, as indicated by traffic signs);

(10) ban stopping by vehicles in lengths of Seagrave Road at any time in certain lengths and between 6 am and Midnight on Mondays to Sundays in other lengths, both Ongar Road and Imperial Road at any time, except for authorised vehicles (the existing on-street parking places in these lengths of roads will be suspended to accommodate this ban).

(11) introduce Last Mile Spectator Crossing points in a length of Lillie Road during times when the authorised traffic sign is displayed and introduce Vehicle Permit Check Points in certain lengths of Lillie Road, Seagrave Road and Ongar Road during times when the authorised traffic sign is displayed.

3. The restrictions specified in paragraph 2 above will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicted by traffic signs, and "official games vehicles" means vehicles authorised by the Olympic Delivery Authority and "authorised vehicles" means vehicles authorised by either the Council or the London Organising Committee for the Olympic Games and Paralympic Games Limited (LOCOG), being mainly shuttle buses, taxis, private hire vehicles and media vehicles carrying passengers to and from the Olympic Games held at the Excel Exhibition Centre.
