DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES – SCHEDULE 154

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council propose to make a Traffic Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and all other enabling powers.

2. The general effect of the Croydon (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. Z21) Traffic Order 2012 would be to:

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Greenwich on 6th July 2012 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The Orders will come into operation on 27th July 2012.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be:
(A) between 27th July 2012 and 9th September 2012 inclusive, to temporarily:

(a) provide permit-holder parking places which will be available to Greenwich Town Centre "G" Controlled Parking Zone permit-holders between 8:30am and 7:00pm throughout the week on:

(i) the south-east side of **College Approach**, from outside No. 2 College Approach to outside the entrance to Greenwich Market; and
(ii) the south-west side of **King William Walk**, outside Nos. 23 to 33 King William Walk; (the north-west side of College Approach and its junction with the northern part of King William Walk will form part of a busy pedestrian route for spectators heading towards the Greenwich Park venue and will therefore be inaccessible to vehicles for safety reasons); and

(b) provide three coach parking places on the south-west side of Woolwich Common which will operate between 6:00am and 7:00pm throughout the week:

(i) to the rear of 66 to 73 Woolwich Common (46 metres in length);
