### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

#### THE A120 TRUNK ROAD (COGGESHALL BYPASS, ESSEX) (50 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 201\_

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that she proposes to make an Order under sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A120 Trunk Road Coggeshall Bypass in Essex.

The effect of the Order would be to impose a 50 miles per hour on the A120 Trunk Road between points 475 metres east of the centre line of its northern junction and 450 metres west of the centre line of its southern junction, with the B1024 Colne Road, Coggeshall, a distance of 975 metres.

The general effect of the East Chiswick 1 parking places order would be to extend the length of the pay and display parking bay opposite The Packhorse and Talbot public house and increase residents' parking bays in Brackley Road by removing sections of single yellow line. Proposed changes to parking bays are detailed in Schedule 1 and 2 of this Notice.
