1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Brent propose to make the above mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, the Parking Acts of 1986 and 1989 and the Traffic Management Act 2004.

2. The general effect of the 'Disabled Persons Parking Places' Order would be to:-

- designate parking places in certain lengths of the streets specified in the Schedule to this Notice in which vehicles authorised by the Order may be left for any period without charge;
- provide that the parking places would operate "at any time";
- specify, in respect of the parking places, that disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge (commonly referred to as "the Blue Badge") issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 may be left therein;
- provide that certain vehicles may wait in the parking places in certain circumstances, e.g., to allow persons to board or alight (maximum 2 minutes), to load or unload (maximum 20 minutes), etc;
- revoke existing disabled parking places outside, No. 30 Ashburnham Road, NW10 5SD, No. 108 Chaplin Road, NW2 5PR, No. 91A Drayton Road, NW10 4DH, No. 84 Gladstone Park Gardens, NW2 6JX, No. 46 Huddlestone Road, NW2 5DN, No. 19 Inman Road, NW10 9JU, No. 108 Palermo Road, NW10 5YN, No. 87 Randall Avenue, NW2 7SX, No. 42 West Ella Road, NW10 9PU and adjacent to No. 101 Anson Road, NW2 4AE;
- make minor drafting amendments to the existing disabled parking place outside No. 21 Inman Road after the revocation of the no longer required disabled parking place outside No. 19 Inman Road.

3. The general effect of the 'Parking Places Amendment' Orders would be to:

- increase in length the existing permit holders only parking places following the revocation of the no longer required disabled persons parking places in Astley Avenue, Chaplin Road, Huddlestone Road, Inman Road and West Ella Road;
- increase in length the existing residents only parking places following the revocation of the no longer required disabled persons parking places in Ashburnham Road and Palermo Road;

(c) shorten in length the existing permit holders only parking places in Brooksville Avenue, Cullingworth Road, Ivy Road and Larch Road to enable for the installation of disabled person parking places;

(d) shorten in length the existing resident only parking places in Albert Road, Connaught Road and Hiley Road to enable for the installation of disabled person parking places.

4. A copy of the proposed Orders, of relevant Orders of 2000, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2008, 2010 and 2012 (and of the Orders which have amended those Orders) of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders and of maps which indicate each length of road to which the Orders relate can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of a period of 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made or the Council decides not to make the Orders at:-

- The One Stop Local Office, Brent Town Hall, Forty Lane, Wembley, Middx, HA9 9HX; and
- The One Stop Local Office, Brent House, 349 - 357 High Road, Wembley, Middx, HA9 6BZ.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Greenwich proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. (1) The general effect of the Orders would be to remove Market Street from the Woolwich Arsenal Controlled Parking Zone (WA) and create the new Woolwich Market Street Controlled Parking Zone (WM) in Market Street, which will operate between the hours of 8:30 am to 6:30 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.

(2) Only those residents whose postal address is included within Nos. 24 to 28 Market Street inclusive will be eligible to purchase parking permits and vouchers for the permit holder only parking places on Market Street. In addition, those residents as specified above will no longer be eligible to purchase permits or vouchers for the Woolwich Arsenal Controlled Parking Zone.

(3) There will be no changes to the general on street layout or to the type of parking places on Market Street.
