HIS being the Birth-Day of Her Royal Highnels the Princels of Wales, there was a very numerous and fplendid Appearance at Court of the Nobility and other Perfons of Diflinction: And at Night there were Illuminations, and other Publick Demonflrations of Joy.

Madrid, Feb. 23, N. S. The Princefs of Afturias having intirely recovered her Health, the publick Rejoicings for her Arrival were begun laft unday Night, by the playing off the Fireworks prepared in the Square before the Palace, the King and Queen with the Prince and Princels of Afturias appearing in a Balcony of the Palace. The Illuminations in the principal Streets and Squares of the City, were continued the next Night, when a great Number of the chief Citizens, richly dreffed in Mafquerade, and ranged in proper Order by the Marquess del Vadillo Corregidor of this City, passed before the Palace, attended by Servants carrying Flambeaux. On Tuelday Night, the Illuminations being continued, their Catholick Majesties, with the Prince and Princess went to the Church of our Lady of Atocha; and in their Return ftopt at a Houfe in the Plaza Mayor, which had been fitted up for their Reception, to fee a very fplendid Masquerade, of Persons of Quality, in two Companies led by the Dukes of Medina Celi and of Arco. The Marof Medina Celi and of Arco. quess de la Fare set out this Morning for Paris, and will be followed in lefs than a Fortnight by the Duke de St. Simon: M. de Chavigny arrived here from Genoa the 16th Inflant. On the 21ft arrived here a Minister from the Czar, to notify his Mafter's having made Peace wich Sweden.

Turin, Feb. 28, N.S. On the 24th, Inftant an Express dispatched by the Count de Saluces brought Advice, that the Marriage of the Prince of Piemont with the Princels of Sultzbach, was folemnized at Sultzbach on the 15th of this Month; and that the 17th was fixed for the Princess's Departure. In the mean Time this Court is preparing with the utmost Diligence for her Reception; and Orders are given for every thing to be ready against the 10th of next Month, about which Time their Sardinian Majefties and the Prince of Piemont will fet out for Vercelli, with the whole Court, to receive the Princels on the Frontiers, where she is expected about the 14th. The Marquess de Martinengo, one of the Gentlemen of the King's Bed-Chamber, a Subject of Venice, and one of the richeft Lords in the Territory of Bressia, is preparing to lodge and entertain her Highnels with great Splendour, at two of his Seats, in her Pallage through that Country. As to the Preparations for her Highness's Reception here, the Street du Po from the Gate of that Name to the Palace, the Square du Chateau, and that of St. Charles, are to be illuminated by Order from Court according to a Model invented by an Architect; and each Window is taxed at four Livres for that purpose. In the reft of the Town where the Princels is not like to pals at her Entry, the Inhabitants are left at Liberty to illuminate in what Form they pleafe, provided no Window have lefs then two Lights.
