HOLBORN CIRCUS AREA ENHANCEMENT

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of London propose to make orders under sections 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. As part of the area enhancement scheme for Holborn Circus it is proposed to:

(a) prohibit the right turn by vehicles from Charterhouse Street into Hatton Garden;

(b) introduce mandatory cycle lanes on the south side of Charterhouse Street and Holborn Viaduct. The cycle lanes would operate between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive

3. A copy of the proposed orders, of the Common Councils statements of reasons for proposing to make the orders and of a plan showing the affected streets can be inspected during normal office hours on Monday to Fridays inclusive within a period of 21 days from the date on which this Notice was published at the Department of the Built Environment, Guildhall, London, EC2P 2EJ.

5. Persons desiring to object to the proposed measures should send a statement of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Director of the Built Environment at the above address within the aforementioned period of 21 days quoting the reference DBE/CT/PA.

STOPPING UP OF PARTS OF DARTMOUTH STREET AND GRANVILLE STREET, ALL SAINTS, WOLVERHAMPTON

ON 29 APRIL 2013 NOTICE WAS GIVEN that the Wolverhampton City Council intended to apply to the Magistrates sitting at the Law Courts, North Street, Wolverhampton, on Tuesday 28 May 2013 for two Orders under Section 116 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising the stopping up of:

1. Two lengths of Dartmouth Street comprising a total area of 610 square metres and a length of Granville Street comprising an area of 70 square metres ("Phase 1A") and

2. A length of Dartmouth Street comprising an area of 161 square metres and a length of Granville Street comprising an area of 915 square metres ("Phase 1B").

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the application was adjourned to a hearing at 2.00pm on 17 June 2013. The hearing will commence by District Judge Wilkinson making an accompanied site visit which will take approximately one hour. This will be followed by a hearing of the Council's application at the Magistrates Court to stop up the sections of highway on the ground that they are unnecessary.
