APPLICATION FOR BLYTH OFFSHORE DEMONSTRATION PROJECT

Notice is hereby given that the National Renewable Energy Centre has applied to the Marine Management Organisation to undertake a regulated activity under Part 4 of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009. The Application is for the following consents 1) Consent under section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989, together with a declaration as to rights of navigation under section 36A of the Electricity Act 1989; and 2) A Marine Licence to construct and maintain marine works under Part 4 of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009.

The application is for the construction and operation (for up to 22 years) of the 'Blyth Offshore Demonstration Project' situated between 5.7 km and 13.8 km off the east coast of Blyth in Northumberland. Narec is seeking consent for 15 turbines to be constructed in 3 arrays, with a maximum number of 5 turbines in each array, at water depths ranging from 35 to 58 m.
