THE HAMMERSMITH AND FULHAM (PARKING PLACES, ZONE "Q") (AMENDMENT NO. 4) ORDER 2013

INTRODUCTION OF A NEW CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE IN THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HAMMERSMITH AND FULHAM

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham on 10th July 2013 made the above Orders under sections 9 and 10 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Orders will come into force on 22nd July 2013 and may continue in force for up to 18 months.

2. The general nature and effect of the Hammersmith and Fulham (Parking Places, Zone "QQ") Order 2013 will be to introduce, as an experiment:

(a) a new Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) "QQ" which will operate Monday to Saturday 9am to 5pm;

(b) CPZ "QQ" will operate permit holder only hours in Novello Street for all residents' permit holders, business permits and Smart Visitor Permits. This means all existing shared-use parking bays in Novello Street will become permit holder only bays; (c) CPZ "QQ" resident permit, business permit and CPZ "QQ" SMART VISITOR PERMIT (SVP) will be created for residents, businesses and residents' visitors of the new Zone;

(d) CPZ "QQ" permit holders will be permitted to park in CPZ "Q".
CPZ "Q" permit holders will not be permitted to park in CPZ "QQ";
(e) Any visitors wishing to park in CPZ "QQ" will only be permitted to do so by displaying an activated and valid CPZ "QQ" SVP. CPZ "Q" SVP holders or business permit holders are not permitted to park in CPZ "QQ";

(f) CPZ "QQ" residents can apply for a maximum of 2 SVPs.

3. The general nature and effect of the Hammersmith and Fulham (Parking Places, Zone "Q") (Amendment No. 4) Order 2013 will be to introduce, as an experiment, an Order which omits any reference to or item reference to Novello Street from that Order.

4. Where it appears necessary for certain purposes, the Head of Highway Maintenance and Projects, or any person authorised by them may modify or suspend the orders or any provisions in it, while the orders are in force.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 11th July 2013 the Council of the London Borough of Haringey, hereinafter called the Council, made the above-mentioned Orders under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be to:---

(a) introduce experimental provisions for the Alexandra Palace CPZ in which the waiting by vehicles, other than in the parking places provided, between the hours of Noon and 2 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive will be prohibited in the streets listed in Schedule 1 to this Notice; (b) designate residents parking places, in the streets listed in Schedule 1 to this Notice, operative between Noon and 2 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive where vehicles displaying a valid residents parking permit or a visitors' permit would be permitted to wait without time limit; (c) designate shared residents and pay and display parking, in the streets listed in Schedule 2 to this Notice, operative between Noon and 2 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, where vehicles displaying:—
