NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest on 26th August 2013 made the above Orders under sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The Orders will come into force on 7th October 2013 and may continue in force for up to 18 months.
- 2. The general effect of the Orders will be to:
- (a) extend the existing boundary of the Wood Street North (WSN) Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) to include Albion Road, Parkstone Road, Prospect Hill, Shernhall Street between its junction with Forest Road and the south-eastern boundary of No. 26 Shernhall Street, Wood Street, between its junction with Forest Road and its junction with Vallentin Road and Wyatts Lane;
- (b) introduce permit holder parking places into Albion Road, Parkstone Road, Prospect Hill, Shernhall Street and Wyatts Lane that will operate between 10am and 4pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- (c) convert the existing voucher parking places in Barrett Road, Havant Road, Marlowe Road and Woodlands Road, to cashless parking places that will operate between 10am and 4pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
- (d) introduce a short stay free parking place into Wyatts Lane that will operate between 10am and 4pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive where vehicles will be permitted to stay for a maximum period of 1 hour with no return within 2 hours;
- (e) introduce a loading bay into **Wyatts Lane**, outside No. 52, that will operate between 8am and 6pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- (f) introduce "at any time" double yellow line waiting restrictions into the lengths of street specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice; and (g) introduce single yellow line waiting restrictions into Shernhall Street, adjacent to No. 26, that will operate between 8am and 6:30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.
- 3. The Wood Street CPZ Order will provide that:
- (a) the operational hours in the CPZ for all parking places will be between 10am and 4pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive;
- (b) vehicles displaying any valid permit displaying the letters WSN will be able use the permit parking places provided in the streets within the WSN CPZ:
- (c) except in the parking places referred to above, waiting by vehicles will be banned in the streets listed in paragraph 2(a) to this Notice between 10am and 4pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive; ["At any time" waiting restrictions in certain areas of certain streets listed in paragraph 2(a) above will also apply]; and
- (d) those addresses specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice relate to those properties whose occupiers are eligible to purchase permits to park in the WSN CPZ.
