THE BEXLEY (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. XX) TRAFFIC ORDER 2013

THE BEXLEY (LOADING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. XX) TRAFFIC ORDER 2013

THE BEXLEY (MISCELLANEOUS PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. XX) TRAFFIC ORDER 2013.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bexley propose to make the above mentioned Orders under sections 6, and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, and all other enabling powers.

2. The general effect of the Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. XX) Traffic Order 2013 would be to introduce lengths of no waiting at any time and no loading at any time restrictions on the southern side of Yarnton Way, to the east of its junction with Wolvercote Road.

3. The general effect of the Bexley (Loading Places) (Amendment No. XX) Traffic Order 2013 would be to introduce a loading place on the south side of Yarnton Way, to the east of its junction with Wolvercote Road. The loading place would for use by goods vehicles only. The times of operation would be Monday to Saturday, 8am to 6.30 pm, the duration of the stay would be limited to 30 minutes, no return within 1 hour.

4. The general effect of the Bexley (Miscellaneous Parking Places) (Amendment No. XX) Traffic Order 2013 would be to introduce limited waiting parking places on the south side of Yarnton Way, to the east of its junction with Wolvercote Road. The parking places would operate Monday to Saturday, 8am to 6.30 pm, the duration of the stay would be limited to 30 minutes, no return within 1 hour.

5. Copies of the proposed Orders mentioned at the head of this notice, the Orders they amend and any other amendments, the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders and a plan indicating the length of road to which the Orders relate can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, at the Contact Centre, Civic Offices, Broadway, Bexleyheath, Kent DA6 7LB.

THE BEXLEY (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION)(AMENDMENT NO. 8) TRAFFIC ORDER 2013

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bexley have on 9th September 2013 made the above mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985.

2. The general effect of the Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. 8) Traffic Order 2013 would be to further amend the Bexley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2012 no. 18 to:-

(a) Extend the existing 'At any time' waiting restrictions in Brook Street, Erith

2. The general effect of the Order will be to:

(a) introduce new "at any time" waiting and loading restrictions in parts of Green Lanes N13 and Green Lanes N21 which are at the junctions with Radcliffe Road N21 and Stonard Road N13;
