DISABLED PARKING PLACES AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN EALING

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing on the 12th September 2013 made the Orders listed in Schedule 1 to this Notice under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be to:

- introduce free parking places for vehicles displaying the disabled person's blue badge permit where such vehicles may be left without limit on time in certain lengths of the roads specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;
- amend the locations of free parking places for vehicles displaying the disabled person's blue badge permit in certain lengths of the roads specified in Schedule 3 to this notice;
- revoke free parking places for vehicles displaying the disabled person's blue badge permit in certain lengths of roads specified in Schedule 4 to this Notice;
- amend existing permit parking places in those roads where the provision of the disabled parking place requires the removal of permit parking or where the removal of the disabled parking place enables additional permit parking to be provided.

3. The Orders, which would come into operation on 16th September 2013, other documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, are available for inspection at Customer Services Reception, Perceval House, 14-16 Uxbridge Road W5 2HL between 9 am and 4:45pm on Monday to Friday, until the 24th October 2013.

4. If any person wishes to question the validity of any of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

ANDRE MALRAUX SCHOOL PROPOSED SAFETY MEASURES

THE EALING (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING OUTSIDE SCHOOLS) (AMENDMENT NO. *) TRAFFIC ORDER 201*

THE EALING (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (SPECIAL PARKING AREA)(AMENDMENT NO. *) ORDER 201*

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing ("the Council") proposes to make the above mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Prohibition of Stopping outside Schools Order would be to revise the school keep clear markings outside the entrance to the Andre Malraux School in Bordsars Road to take account of the crossing point in Bordsars Road. Vehicles would continue to be prohibited from stopping on the markings between 8.00 am and 9.30 am and between 3pm and 4.30pm on Mondays to Fridays.
