**Mansfield District Council****PLANNING LISTED BUILDINGS AND CONSERVATION AREAS ACT 1990, SECTION 69****VARIATION OF THE BRIDGE STREET AND MARKET PLACE CONSERVATION AREAS**

Notice is given under the provisions of the 1990 Act that Mansfield District Council, has determined that the area described in the schedule to this Notice is an area of special architectural or historic interest and that it is desirable to preserve or enhance its character or appearance. It has accordingly modified the existing Bridge Street and Market Place Conservation Areas so as to include this area.

The principle effects of this area being designated as a conservation area are as follows:

1. The Council is under a duty to prepare proposals to ensure the preservation and enhancement of the area.
2. Consent must be obtained from the Council for the demolition of any building in the area.
3. Special publicity must be given to planning application for development in the area.
4. In carrying out any functions under the planning acts (and in particular in determining applications for planning permission and listed building consent), the Council and the Secretary of State are required to take into account the desirability of preserving or enhancing the character or appearance of the area.
5. Six weeks notice must be given to the Council before works are carried out to any tree in the area.

Land associated with 49-57 (odds) Leeming Street. Land associated with the junction of Leeming Street and St Peter's Way. Land and buildings associated with 9-13 (odds) West Gate. Land associated with the Stan Hope Centre, Rock Valley.
