This Court has likewise sent Orders to the Governments of Tripoli, Tunis, and Algier, to fit out as many of their Ships as they can to join them, and have appointed Janom Choggia (who is the ablest Seaman they have) to command the Fleet. He is now at Tripoli, whence he is to remove to Scio, where the Fleet is to meet him, and the ten Men of War are already sailed out of this Port. The Enterprize concerted is kept secret, but is conjectured to be against a little Island called Gozo near Malta, which is or may be made strong, so as to serve to bridle the Maltese Rovers, if

it can be taken.

Vienna, June 13, N. S. Letters from Constantinople advise, that Expresses were come to the Ottoman Port from different Parts of Persia, bringing Accounts that the Kingdom of Persia has been attacked by two Armies of Rebels, one headed by Miriveis, and the other by Scheich Mahmud; the first having over-run all the Country from Candachar to Ispahan, laid Siege to that Capital, took and plundered it, and also made himfelf Master of the Castle, the King of Persia with only three or four Persons, esca-Corfairs; and ten Men of War have with him a numerous Army, the greatest Part
