NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A63 and A1033 Trunk Roads in the East Riding of Yorkshire, which comes into force on Friday 31 January 2014.
