1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Royal Borough of Greenwich on 24th February 2014 made the abovementioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The Orders will come into operation on 3rd March 2014.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be to:

(a) relocate north-eastwards by 1.2 metres, a permit parking place in Earlshall Road, the north-west side, outside Nos. 25 and 27 Earlshall Road;

(b) shorten a permit holder parking place by 5.5 metres on the northeast side of Tarves Way (south-west arm), approximately 130 metres south-east of Norman Road (at the south-eastern end of the existing parking place) and replace that parking space with a Car Club parking place for one vehicle;

(c) shorten by 4 metres and relocate north-eastwards by 1.5 metres a permit parking place on the north-west side of Commerell Street outside the St. Joseph's Community Centre and provide car club parking place for one vehicle in that location; and

(d) provide double yellow line 'at any time' waiting restrictions in the lengths of street referred to in the Schedule to this Notice.
