THE A428 TRUNK ROAD (CAXTON GIBBET, CAMBRIDGESHIRE) (DERESTRICTION AND VARIATION) ORDER 201_

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 82(2)(a) and 83(1) of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A428 Trunk Road at Caxton Gibbet in Cambridgeshire.

The effect of the Order would be to remove the 30 miles per hour speed limit automatically imposed by the installation of street lighting and restore the national speed limit of either 60 or 70 miles per hour on the A428 Trunk Road between points 116 metres west and 117 metres east of the A1198 Caxton Gibbet roundabout, including the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout.

The A428 Trunk Road Caxton Common to Hardwick, Cambridgeshire) (De-restriction) Order 2007/3131 would be varied by this Order, by removing any reference to the A428 at Caxton Gibbet.
