Also at times, on the above lengths of carriageway, traffic will be diverted on to the opposite carriageways using a contraflow system. Traffic management will be in operation 24 hours a day and traffic signs will indicate the extent of the restrictions (which will not apply to emergency service vehicles) and prohibitions (which will not apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles being used in connection with the said works or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes or to anyone engaged in the said works).

- The general nature and effect of the Order is to introduce a 20 m.p.h speed limit on the following roads where Transport for London is the traffic authority (as indicated by single or double red line markings):
- (1) In both directions for the full length of; Bishopsgate, Gracechurch Street, Norton Folgate, Farringdon Street, New Bridge Street, Blackfriars Bridge, King William Street, Alderman's Walk, Arthur Street, Brushfield Street, Camomile Street, Cannon Street, Cornhill, Eastcheap, Fenchurch Street, Fish Street Hill, Folgate Street, Leadenhall Street, Liverpool Street, Lombard Street, Monument Street, New Street, Primrose Street, Spital Square, Threadneedle Street, White Hart Court, Wormwood Street and Worship Street,
- (2) Farringdon Road, both sides from the junction with Charterhouse Street for a distance of 25 metres in a northern direction;
- (3) London Bridge, from the borough boundary with London Borough of Southwark to the junction with King William Street;
- (4) Victoria Embankment slip road (Eastbound) from No 60 Victoria Embankment to the junction with New Bridge Street;
- (5) Victoria Embankment slip road (Westbound) from the junction with Blackfriars Bridge for a distance of 12 metres.
