PROPOSED REDUCTION TO OFF STREET CAR PARKING AREA IN GILLETT ROAD, THORNTON HEATH.

- 1 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Croydon Council propose to make a Traffic Order under Sections 32, 35, 124 of, and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended and all other enabling powers.
- 2 The general effect of the Order would be to reduce in size and capacity the car parking area known as Gillett Road Car Park, available only to Housing permit holders. The area of the car park to be revoked is to the rear of Nos. 37 to 44 Cotford Road and Nos. 6 to 6c Gillett Road and immediately to the south-west of the access road from Gillett Road leading to the car park.

The car parking area to be retained provides enough capacity to accommodate existing permit holders.
