

Pursuant to sub-section 247 (2B) of the 1990 Act, it is proposed that the order will also provide for a highway improvement, namely the widening of the footway in Douglas Street (situated adjacent to the highway to be stopped up) by 0.92 metres along a 30.9 metre length.
