H E Affembly of the Burghers has agreed with thole of the Nobility and Clergy, in a Refolution not to make any Alteration in the prefent established Form of the Government of this Kingdom. Which Resolution has been fignified to the Pealants, who having judged fome Alteration necessary, had defired the Concurrence of those other States.

Hague, March 16, N. S. The Marquels de Monteleone the Spanish Ambassadour, had a Conference Yesterday with the Deputies of the States General, when he acquainted them by Order from his Court, that a Squadron of Ships to be commanded by the Marquess de Mari is fitting out at Cadiz, to act this Sum-mer against the Algerines, in Conjunction with the Squadron which this State shall think fit to fend into the Mediterranean, and which he defired might be ordered thither with all possible Dispatch. The Deputies of the Admiralties being now here to be confulted about fitting out of the faid Squadron, it is expected a final Refolution upon that Affair will be taken in a few Days. Eight Deputies from Zealand are arrived here to confer with the States of Holland about their Maritime Affairs and the Farming of the Cuftoms, in order to which they prefented Yesterday to the Affembly their Powers or Credentials. Letters from Molcow relate, that Baron Schaffiroff, Chancellour to the Czar, had by his Order been taken into Cuftody, and all his Papers and Effects fecured, and that fince his Confinement he had charged Prince Menzicoff and Admiral Apraxin with the fame Crimes he is acculed of.

Spanifb-Town in Jamaica, Dec. 26. His Grace the Duke of Portland, with his Retinue, arrived fafe here on the 22d Inftant; and was received with all Demonstrations of publick Joy.
