## Pifa, March 3, N. S.

UR Letters from Florence advife, that the Marquifs Corfini, eldest Bro-ther of the Marquils of that Name now reliding at Cambray as Minister from the Great Duke, is made Chief Ranger to his Highness. Prince Theodore of Ba varia, who had passed fome Time here, is gone from hence to Rome. Orders are come to feveral Parts of Italy, for all fuch Knights of Malta as are of the Age of 19 Years complear, and all those above that Age who have not yet ferved in any military Expedition, to repair forthwith to the Island of Malta : But the more antient Knights, who have formerly been in Service, are excufed from repairing thither, till they receive a third peremptory Summons. From Leghorne we have an Account, that by Letters from Algiers it was confirmed, that the Algerine Squadron had put to Sea, in order to join the Ottoman Fleet in the Dardanells: They add, that the Turks were floring Magazines at feveral Places on the Coafts of Barbary, for supplying their Fleet as Occasion may require.

Turin, March 10, N. S. On the 7th Inftant about Nine a Clock at Night the Princels Royal of Piedmont was fately delivered of a Prince, who was foon after baptized, the Marquils de la Pietre being Proxy for the Prince of Sultzbach as Godfather, and the Princels de la Cifferna for Madame Royale as Godmother; and he was named Victor Amedés Theodore. Her Royal Highnels was taken very ill that Night, and continued fo bad, that fhe was not judged to be out of Danger till Yefterday. To Day Te Deum is to be fung, and Orders are given for Illuminations to be made throughout the City this and the three following Nights; and extraordinary Rejoycings will be made at Court on this joyful Occafion. His Sardinian Majefty and the Prince Royal have fent Letters, to be delivered to the King of Great Britain, by the Marquifs de Cortaole, his Sardinian Majefty's Minister refiding at London, notifying the Birth of the young Prince. The Count de Maffey is appointed to go with like Letters of Notification to the Court of France; and the Chevalier de Villetre, his Sardinian Majefty's Mafter of the Horfe, fets out To-morrow for Sultzbach, on the fame Occafion.

Cambray, March 11, N.S. His Excellency the Lord Polwarth, one of the British Ambaffadours Plenipotentiary to the Congress here, gave this Day a very magnificent Entertainment to all the Foreign Ministers and other Persons of Distinction residing in this City, on Occasion of the Birth-Day of her Royal Highness the Princess of Wales, which is To-morrow: But that being a Fast-Day, his Excellency chose to celebrate the faid Anniversary To-Day.
