1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the London Borough of Ealing ("the Council") proposes to make the above mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Waiting Restriction Amendment would be (a) to impose waiting restrictions applying at any time in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice and (b) impose waiting restrictions applying between 7am and 6pm on Mondays to Fridays in the length of Conway Crescent specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

3. The general effect of the Prohibition of Stopping outside Schools Order would be to revise the existing school keep clear markings outside the entrances to Selborne Primary School in Conway Crescent and Thames Avenue. Stopping by vehicles would continue to be prohibited between 8am and 9.30am and between 3pm and 4.30pm on Mondays to Fridays.
