TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

THE STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAYS (LAYBY AT CAE GWILYM LANE, CEFN MAWR, WREXHAM) ORDER 2016

The Welsh Ministers have made an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act") to authorise the stopping up of the length of highway described in Schedule 1 to this Notice to enable the development described in Schedule 2 to be carried out. The Stopping Up of Highways (Layby at Cae Gwilym Lane, Cefn Mawr, Wrexham) Order 2016 ("the Order"), will cease to have effect if planning permission in respect of the development expires or is revoked.
