THE CITY OF LONDON (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO. 20) ORDER 2016

2. The effect of the Orders will be to:-

(a) make permanent the provisions of The City of London (Prescribed Routes) (No. 2) Experimental Traffic Order 2015 and The City of London (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Experimental Order 2015, namely to introduce:-

(A) a prohibition on vehicles with a maximum gross weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes from entering Printer Street and West Harding Street 'at any time'; and

(B) 'at any time' waiting restrictions and loading restrictions operating 'between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive' in:-

(1) East Harding Street, on the south side and on the north side at the junction with Printer Street;

(2) Pemberton Row, on the north side;

(3) Printer Street, on the west side; and

(4) West Harding Street, on the north and north-east side;

(b) consolidate into one Order the 7.5T weight limits in the City of London by revoking The City of London (Weight Restriction) Traffic Order 2007 and Articles 5 and 7 of The City of London (Prescribed Routes) (Queen Street) Traffic Order 2005.

3.
