#### LONDON BOROUGH OF HACKNEY THE HACKNEY (WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING RESTRICTIONS) (AMENDMENT NO.8) ORDER 2017 THE HACKNEY (PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO.8) ORDER 2017

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the London Borough of Hackney on 27th January 2017 did make the above-mentioned Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be to introduce the following changes on

Whiston Road;

- Remove residents permit bay and double yellow lines adjacent to Bryant Street to install a Zebra Crossing;
- Reduce the lengths of bus stops to the west of Cester Street replacing with double yellow lines;
- Remove 2 resident permit bays outside Woolstone House replacing with double yellow lines;
- Replace 2 resident permit bays east of Nicholl Street with double yellow lines;
- Relocate the length of bus stop outside Muscott House to outside Wislow House and replace with double yellow lines;
- Remove 6 resident permit bays outside Northchurch House and replace with double yellow lines.

Hay Street

- Introduce new resident permit and permit bays in new layby outside Northchurch House

2. The general effect of the Orders will be to;

- Britannia Walk - Convert existing pay and display bay opposite Eagle Point to a loading bay.
  - Britannia Walk - Add no loading 'at any time' restriction to the western kerb of Britannia Walk between its junctions with City Road and Ebenezer Street.
  - Broadway Estate - Remove 4 parking spaces at the rear of 10-12 Broadway Market and replace with double yellow lines.
  - Broadway Estate - Implement 4 parking spaces adjacent to Ada Street replacing a section of double yellow lines
  - Broadway Estate Implement 2 parking spaces at the side of Broadway House replacing a section of double yellow lines.
  - Broadway Estate - Relocate parking spaces adjacent to Sheep Lane 5m south replacing a section of double yellow lines.
  - Bush Road - Remove a 4m section of the existing resident bay at the side of the bus garage and replace it with double yellow lines.
  - Chatsworth Road - Remove an 11m section of the existing resident bay outside 1 to 18 Chatsworth Estate and replace with double yellow lines.
  - Chatsworth Road - Remove a 7m section of the shared use bay outside Clapton Park Methodist Church and replace with double yellow lines.
  - Geffrye Estate - Remove permit bay outside 1 to 34 Geffrye Court and replace with double yellow lines.
  - Hackney Road - Convert existing loading bay opposite number 74 to 86 Hackney Road to shared use loading bay and taxi bay. Loading permitted only between 7am and 7pm and no waiting taxi bay between 7pm and 7am.
  - Lower Clapton Road - Replace a section of double yellow lines opposite 152 to 154 Lower Clapton Road with a shared use bay (permit or pay and display - 4hr max stay).
  - Mildenhall Road - Replace a section of double yellow lines opposite the side of 158 Lower Clapton Road with a permit bay.
  - Millfields Road - Change existing permit bay opposite numbers 3 to 13 Millfields Road to pay by phone only shared use bay - 4hr max stay.
  - Nile Street - Remove the permit bay and car club bay on southern side of Nile Street (outside No.32) and replace with a single yellow line
  - Nile Street - Remove the permit bay (5 spaces) on northern side of Nile Street (opposite No.s 40 - 42) and replace with a double yellow lines.
  - Kingsland Road - Remove a section of the echelon shared use bay (1 space) and a section of double yellow line outside numbers 464 - 466 and replace with a new motorcycle bay.
  - Shenfield Street - Remove echelon resident bay on southern kerb adjacent to Stanway Court and replace with double yellow lines.
  - Theydon Road - Relocate disabled bay from outside No.2 Theydon Road to outside No.10 Theydon Road
  - Tiger Way - Remove permit bays opposite numbers 10 to 16 Tiger Way and replace with double yellow lines.
