The revision will be made to sections 1, 2 and 3 of the NTC and implemented in the DCUSA on 23 February 2017. Private network operators may be impacted by this change.

This change modifies the NTC so that they apply to LDNOs' connections to unlicensed networks at which there is no boundary metering for settlement purposes. #### LONDON BOROUGH OF WALTHAM FOREST PROPOSED PARKING AMENDMENTS CHANGES TO EXISTING PARKING PLACES IN CONTROLLED PARKING ZONES (CPZ)

Note: (This notice is about reducing the length of certain parking places in the roads described below so as to allow for the installation of secure bicycle parking structures instead.)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest on 20th February 2017 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

- 2. The general effect of the Orders would be to reduce the length of existing permit parking space by 2.5 metres at the following locations, to make space for the provision of secure bicycle parking structures:

- (i) **Howard Road, E17 (ME CPZ)** outside No. 48;
- (k) **Jewel Road, E17 (HS CPZ)** outside No. 38;
- (I)Lister Road, E11 (LSE CPZ) outside No. 2;
- (m) Livingstone Road, E17 (BA CPZ) outside No. 85;
- (n) Madeira Road, E11 (LSW CPZ) opposite Nos. 7 and 9;
- (o) Mersey Road, E17 (WA CPZ) outside Nos. 25/27 and outside Nos. 102/104:
- (p) Millais Road, E11 (LNS CPZ) outside No. 97;
- (q) Turner Road, E17 (WSN CPZ) outside No. 23;
- (r) Waverley Road, E17 (WSN CPZ) outside No. 55; and

Note: The Orders are necessary to make space for the provision of secure bicycle parking structures for residents who do not have the space and/or ability to securely park bicycles in or within a reasonable distance from their home.

- 3. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on **20th February 2017** and other relevant documents can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from that date, at: (a) The Information Desk, Town Hall, Forest Road, Walthamstow, E17; and (b) Low Hall, Argall Avenue, London, E10 7AS.

Any person desiring to question the validity of either of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the making of the Orders, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
