Madrid, November 22, N. S. N the 12th Inftant in the Evening, Mr. Stanhope, the British Ambassadour, TOturned hither from Arnedillo, where he had been some Weeks to use the Waters for his Health, and has found great Benefit by them. On the 14th, his Excellency receiving Difpatches by a Cabinet Courier from Paris, went to the King at St. Ildefonfo, and delivered to his Ma-jelty the Draughts of the Inveftitures of Tufcamy, Parma, and Placentia, as agreed to by the Emperour in the Form defired by this Court. Catholick Majefty's Approbation of those Draughts. Lisbon, Nov. 27, N. S. On the 20th Inflant, the Victoria, a Portugueze Man of War that failed from hence about three Weeks ago to guard the Coaft, brought in an Algerine Cruizer of 26 Guns, 10 Patereroes, and 250 Men, which fhe took the 13th 40 Leagues to the Weftward of Cape Mondego, after an Engagement in which 26 of the Algerines were killed, and 6 wounded, with the Lols on our Side of 2 Men killed, and 6 wounded. On board were found 19 Christians of feveral Nations, four of whom are Portu-gueze; the Moors taken in her have been fince put into the Gallies here. His Portugueze Maje-fty found himfelf out of Order the 18th and 19th Inftant ; his Indifpolition was thought Aguish, but the Fit had no Return, and he is now per-fectly recovered.
