HE Diet of the States of this Kingdom being brought to a Conclusion, the four Orders of the laid States met at the Great Hall of the Court the 28th Inftant, and according to Cuftom waited on the King in a Body to take their Leave of him. Before the Nobility feparated, they elected Count Horn to be first Director of their House in the Room of Count Charles Gyllenstierna, who died fome Months ago. M. Rumpf, who was feveral Tears Refident at this Court from the States General, and has been for fome Months paft in Holland, returned bither this Day from thence with the Character of Envoy Extraordinary.
