Main reasons/ conclusions on which decision is based

Main considerations related to discharges to the marine environment and atmospheric emissions. Chemical discharges assessed as no risk to environment and atmospheric emissions rapidly dispersed to background levels. Impacts were localised and insignificant.

Mitigation features/ measures

Produced water discharge treated to meet required standard, and appropriate controls in place to reduce the likelihood of accidental events. Agreement given to the issue of consent, providing works are undertaken as specified in the application.

Having regard to the relevant application(s) for direction(s) submitted under the above Regulations, the Secretary of State has assessed the project(s) as not likely to have a significant effect on the environment, and has given a direction that the application for consent under the Petroleum Act 1998 need not be accompanied by an environmental statement.
