

**DEPARTMENT FOR TRANSPORT

The Secretary of State gives notice of an Order made under Section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping up of Highway (North East) (No.8) Order 2018" authorising the stopping up of the whole of the pedestrian subway and stairway beneath Milburngate Bridge including the whole of the unnamed footpath and stairway connecting to Milburngate Bridge at Durham in the City of Durham to enable development as permitted by Durham County Council, under reference DM/16/01228/FPA.
