Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the making of the Orders, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest (the Council) on 25th June 2018 made the above mentioned Traffic Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The general effect of the Orders will be to continue indefinitely certain provisions of the experimental traffic orders listed in the Schedule to this Notice, which by way of an experiment -

- (a) in Langthorne Road E10,-
  - (i) suspended all permit parking places adjacent the flank walls of Nos. 28, 31 and 33 Grove Green Road;
  - (ii) introduced a road closure to vehicular traffic (except for cycles) between its junction with Grove Green Road and the northern kerb line of Trelawn Road/Langthorne Road (junction with Colville Road); and
  - (iii) provided "at any time" waiting restrictions across the section closed to vehicular traffic;
- (b) in Grove Green Road E11, suspended permit parking space outside Nos. 24 Grove Green Road;
- (c) in Richmond Road E11,
- (i) introduced a road closure to vehicular traffic (except for cycles) between its junction with Grove Green Road and the northern kerb line of Pretoria Road; and
- (ii) allowed right turn movements for pedal cycles from Grove Green Road E11 to Richmond Road E11
- (d) in Hampton Road E11

(i) prohibited vehicles (except cycles) from proceeding at any time in any direction other than from south-west to north-east;

(ii) prevented vehicles entering (except cycles) Hampton Road E11 at its junction with Grove Green Road;

(e) in Rhodesia Road E11 (between its junction with Norlington Road and Grove Green Road)

(i) prohibited vehicles (except cycles) from proceeding at any time in any direction other than from north-east to south-west;

(ii) prevented vehicles entering (except cycles) Rhodesia Road E11 at its junction with Norlington Road.

(f) in Northcote Road E17 (between Warner Road and Palmerston Road):

(i) north-west side - suspended all MW permit parking;

(ii) south-east side - suspended Free Short Stay (FSS) parking;

(iii) provided double yellow lines "at any time" waiting restrictions at either end of the road closure; and

(iv) introduced a road closure to vehicular traffic (except for cycles) into Northcote Road E17.

(g) in Greville Road E17:

(i) east side - suspended permit parking space located outside the flank wall of No. 1 Oliver Road;

(ii) west side - suspended FSS parking space located outside the flank wall of No. 171 Shernhall Street;

(iii) provided double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions at either end of the road closure and immediately north of the road closure on both sides for 8 metres; and

(iv) introduced a road closure to vehicular traffic (except for cycles) into Greville Road E17, between its junction with Shernhall Street northwards for a distance of 16 metres.

NOTES: more specific details of the above-mentioned provisions are contained in the notices of making of the original experimental traffic orders as advertised in Waltham Forest News issue 177 dated 6th Feb 2017 and issue 179 dated 6th March.
