1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest (therein after called "the Council") on 25th June 2018 made the above-mentioned Order under sections 32, 35 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the "Off-Street" Order will be to introduce the following car parks:

(a) MARSH LANE, E10; and (entrance via Marsh Lane)

(b) SEYMOUR ROAD, E10 (entrance via Seymour Road)

As Free Short Stay Car Parks for authorized vehicles only.

Nb. Marsh Lane car park will have 3 disabled persons only parking spaces (blue badge (bb) holders only) and Seymour Road car park will have 2 disabled persons only parking spaces ((bb) holders only) and 1 parking space for buses only (8 seats and over). The car park's hours of operation and periods of stay along with other regulations are listed in the Schedule to this notice and will apply to all users of the aforementioned car parks. Additional information with regard to parking compliance will be displayed on the Council's terms and conditions information board within the aforementioned car parks.

3. FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council on 25th June 2018 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

(a) formalise the existing double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions in Marsh Lane E10 – both sides - between a point 35 metres west of the eastern edge of the bridge crossing the Dagenham Brook and a point adjacent the south-westernmost boundary of proposed Marsh Lane car park;

(a) Orient Way E10 -

a. convert all laybys on the north-east side to Free Short Stay parking places operating every day of the week with a maximum stay of 3 hours and no return in 4 hours;

b. remove the layby on the south-west side (this area will default to No Stopping "At Any Time").

4. Copies of the Orders, the Council's statement of reasons of Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation from 25th June 2018 and other relevant documents can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from that date, at: (a) The Information Desk, Town Hall, Forest Road, Walthamstow, E17; and (b) Low Hall, Argall Avenue, London, E10 7AS.

5. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the making of the Orders, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
