An AG for explatining and amending an Act of the laft Seffion of narliamenr, Intituled, An Act to oblige all idejms, being Papifts, in that Part of Great Britoin ia cd Scoiland, and all Perfons in Great Britain, ra, ling or neglecting to take the Oaths appoixted for le Security of His Majeffy's Perfon ana' $G$ vermment, by fevaral Altis berces mentioned, to Regiftor their Nin ras and real Efates, and for enlarging the Tim : fur taking the faid' Oaths, and making fuch Regirrers, and for allowing farther lime for the Inrolment of Deeds or Wills made by Papitts, which have been omitted to be enrolled, purs fuant to an Act of the Third Year of His Mejefty's Reign; and alfo for giving Relief to Proteftant Leffees.

THE Preamble recites the faid former Act fo to be explained and amended, and then it is enacted, That nothing in the faid recired at concained thall be conitrued to extend to oblige any Woman whatfoever to take the faid Oaths, or to take and fubfribe the faid Oaths, ind fubfribe the faid Affurance, or to regifter her Name, or real Eftate; nor co oblige any Perfons whatfoever to take the faid Oaths, or to take and fubferibe the faid Oaths, and fubferibe the faid Affurance, or to regifter their Names, and real Eftates, who had only an Eftate or Intereft in Lands, Tenenements, or Hereditaments, in Reverfion, or Remainder Expectant, upon the Determination of any Eftate-Tail, or Eftate for Life, or Lives, or for Years dererminable on any Life or Lives, (where no Rent was referved on fuch Eftate for Life or Lives, or for Years) or who had only an Eftate or Intereft in Lands, Fenements, or Hereditaments, as Morrgages, or by way of Security for Money, or Relief of any Engagement, or by way of Warranty, not being in rhe actual Poffeffion thereof, or who had only an Eftate or Intereft in Lands, Tenements, or Herieditaments, in Truft for fome other Perfon or Perfons, and not for their own Ufe or Benefit; or who had only an Eftate or Intereft in Lands, Tenements, or Hereditaments, as Tenants or Farmers, by virtue of any Leafe or Leafes, whereupon two Thirds of the full yearly Value, or more, were referved; or who had not at fome Time, between the Twenty feventh Day of May, and the Twenty fifth Day of December, in the Year of our Lord One thoufand feven hundred and twenty three, any Lands, Tenements, or Hereditaments, of the clear yearly Value of Ten Pounds, or upwards, over and above all Reprizes whereof they, or fome Perfon or Perfons in Truft for them, or for their Benefit, were in the Poffeffion and Receipt of the Rents or Profits; or who bad at any Time, before the Twenty feventh Day of May, in the Year of our Lord One thoufand feven bundred and twenty three, taken the Oaths preferibed and appointed by the faid Act, made in the Firft Year of His Majefty's Reign, in either Houfe of Parliament, or in any of His Majefty's Courts of Record at Weftminfter, or at any General or Quarter-Seffions of the Peace; or who had, at any Time before the faid Twenty feventh Day of May, One thoufand feven hundred and twenty three, taken and fubfcribed the Oath of Allegiance, fubfcribed the Affurance,
and taken and figned the Oath of Abjuration, as dire $\theta$ ed to be taken and fubferibed by the faid laft mentioned Act, or any fubfequent Act, in the Courc of Seflion, Court of Juficiary or Exchequer in Scotland, or at any Quarter-Seflions of the Peace, or before any Sheriffs or Ste warts, or their Deputies, in open Courr, held for fome Shire, Stewartry, Clity, or Burgh, in Scotlanda or as a Juftice or Juftices of the Peace, or as Magiftrate or Town-Counfellor of any Royal Borough, or Voter for a Reprefenrative in Parliament fis any County or Place in Scotland refpectively : Bu il and every fuch Perfon and Peifons are ther by deciared to be freed, indempnified, and catarged, and are chereby freel, indermified, and difcharged from all Penalties and reitures for or by Reafon of his, her, or t ) mo t king the faid Oaths, or not taking and fubferbing the faid Oaths, and fubferibing the faid Affurance, or not regiftring bis, her, or their Names, and sal Eftares, in purfuance of the faid recierd $P$ \&t.
And for enlarging the Time for raking the faid Oathe, within England, Wales, and the 「own of ferwick upon Tweed. and for taking and fubferibing the laid $\mathrm{O}_{\text {aths }}$, and fubreribing the fald Af. fיrare, ithin Scotland, by Perfons by the faid Act obliged and intended to take and fubfcribe the fame, or any of rhem refpectively, or in Defaule thereof,for regiftring the Nam-s and real Eftates of fuch Perfons; it is further enacted, That all and every Perfon and Perfons who, by the true Intent and Meaning of the faid recited Act, according to the Declaration before-mentioned, was or were required to take the faid Oaths, or to take and fubfribe the faid Oaths, and fubfcribe the faid Aftusance, not having raken and fubfribed the fame refpectively, purfuant to the Directions of the hid recited Act, fhall take the faid Oaths, or take and fubfribe che faid $\mathrm{O}_{\text {aths }}$, and fubforibe the faid Affurance, in fome of the Courrs or Places wherein the fame were in and by the faid recited ACt appointed to be taken by fuch Perfon and Perfons refpectively, or in fuch Court or Place, and in fucb Manner, as is by this Aat directed, on or before the Twenty eighth Day of November, One thoufand feven hundred and twenty four, and thereupon thall be difcharged from any Obligation to regifter his or their Names and real Eftate or Eftates, in purfuance of the faid recited Act; and in Default of taking the faid Oaths, or taking and fubferibing the faid Oaths, and fubfetibing the faid Affurance refpectively, as the Cafe thall require, in fuch Manner, and within fuch Time, as is for that Purpofe above-mentioned, all and every fuch Perfon and Perfons fhall, on or before the Twenty fourth Day of June, One thoufand feven hundred and twenty five, regifter, or caufe or procure to be regiftred, his or their Name or Names, and all fuch Lands, Tenements, and Hereditaments, whereof he or they, or any Perfon or Perfons in Truft for him or them, or for his or their Benefir, fhall be in Poffeffion, or in the Receipt or Perception of the Rents or Profits which thall be fituate, lying, or arifing within Great Britain, in fuch Courts and Places, and in fuch Manner and Form, as are after for that Purpofe refpectively directed and appointed.
And it is further enacted, That every fuch Regiffry thall exprefs in what Parifh, Townaip, Bergh, or
