It having been agreed, that the Spaniards should restore the Artillery carried away by them from Sardinia while they were Mafters of that Island, or give an Equivalent for the same, there is to be a Meeting in a few Days at Genoa, to regulate the Value of the faid Artillery ; the Commiffaries on the Part of Spain, are the Marquess de St. Philippe Envoy at Genoz, and the Marquels de Santa Cruz Major-General, who has been detained till now as Hostage for the Performance of this Treaty; and on the King of Sardinia's fide are the Count de Sr. Lazare Major General, and the Count de Groffi Resident from this Court at Genoa. Monday last in the Evening, his Sardinian Majesty went to the Veneria, where he lay all Night, and the next Day the Prince went to Superga, a famous Convent now Camp in order to attack it in 1706.
